Data reporting required for sheltered persons in the Exhibit 1 Continuum of Care plans. The federal grant form does not require the continuum of care to report the unsheltered homeless veteran population. Therefore, some continuums report only the sheltered population as the total homeless veterans population.

For comparison, the homeless coalitions reported a total homeless veterans population of 5,966 based on the point in time count conducted in January 2007. This reflected 17.1 % of the total homeless population.
